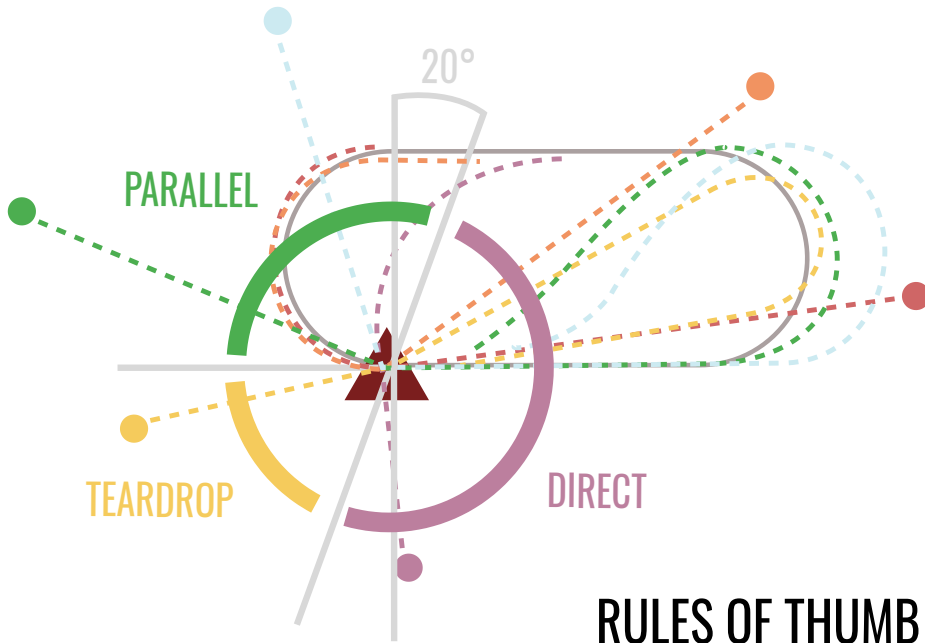


HOLD ENTRIES



THE HEADING INDICATOR METHOD

1. Proceed direct to the holding fix
2. Determine the hold's outbound course
3. Visualize the outbound course on the DG
4. Outbound course sector determines entry type



Non-Standard (Left Turns)

Standard (Right Turns)

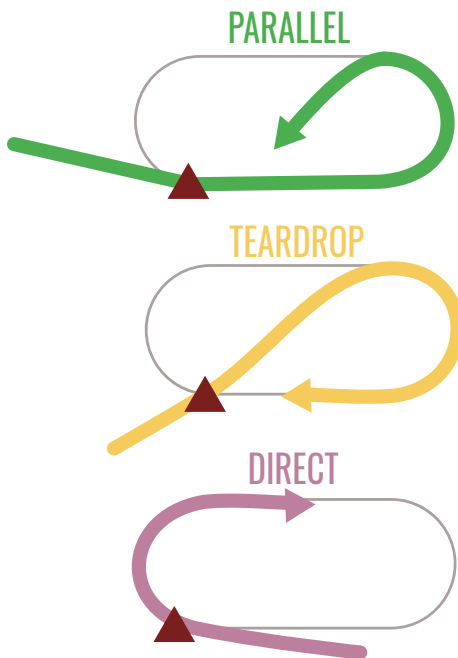
Outbound Course Sectors

RULES OF THUMB

If the O/B course is **behind** you, it's direct.

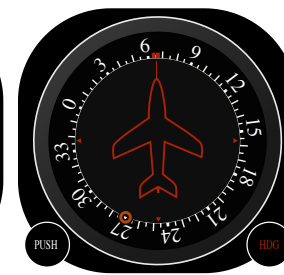
If the shortest turn to the O/B course is **in the direction** of hold the hold, it's teardrop.

If the shortest turn to the O/B course is **opposite the direction** of the hold, it's parallel.



OUTBOUND COURSE

Teardrop entry if standard
Parallel entry if non-standard



OUTBOUND COURSE

Direct entry for both standard
and non-standard holds



OUTBOUND COURSE

Parallel entry if standard
Direct entry if non-standard
